

(whether single or married)



Affection / Storge

- Friendship / Philia
- Romance / Eros

Charity / Agape



Christian Love

- Affection (Storge) is family love. As Christians we are all of same household of faith, brothers and sisters.
- Charity (Agape) is sacrificial love. Jesus commands his followers to "love one another".
- Friendship (*Philia*) is companion love, built on trust, knowledge, and common pursuit.
- Romance (*Eros*) is partner love, bond leads a woman and a man to marriage.



Christian Friendship (Complete in God)

- Prepare yourself for romance and dating by having a FULL HEART and not a HUNGRY HEART.
- Don't expect a partner to fill a void that only God can fill.



Christian Friendship (A friend before a date)

- Trust
- Knowledge
- Affection

Three aspects of Friendship



Trust

(A foundation of friendship)

- Assured reliance on the character, ability, strength, or truth of someone – one in whom confidence is placed.
- Takes time



Knowledge (A foundation of friendship)

- Awareness, understanding, a clear idea of someone
- Takes time



Affection (A foundation of friendship)

- a feeling of liking and caring for someone
- May happen quickly

Christian Dating

- A deliberate meeting with a person of opposite sex without a commitment to marry but with marriage as a possibility. A romantic encounter.
- Dating is not addressed in Scripture.
- The Prime Directive: "Do not be unequally yoked with an unbeliever".

What to Look for When Dating

- INWARD Character
- OUTWARD Modesty
- UPWARD Devotion





INWARD Character

- Do words match deeds?
- Observe the person under stress and while suffering
- Does the person forgive?
- Seek out public reputation





OUTWARD Modesty

- In speech
- In dress
- In behavior





UPWARD Devotion

- Does the partner seek to please God, more than to please you?
- Is God the primary relationship? What is the evidence?
- Is the partner active in service to God?

A Suggested Approach


- Ladies, if you know gentleman is of good character, and you are available, if he asks for a date, please accept his offer and say YES. You never know.
- Gentleman, if after a first date you ask for a second date and Lady says NO, please accept her refusal with grace and do not pursue.



RED FLAGS

- 1. Drinking too much.
- 2. Asking questions that are too personal.
- 3. Asking or talking about sex.
- 4. Acts rudely to others during the date.
- 5. Talking about an ex negatively.
- 6. Having a jealous streak.
- 7. Using religion as a hammer.

Check for red & yellow flags before becoming exclusive.



YELLOW FLAGS

- 1. Sneaky about phone
- 2. Monopolizes conversation
- 3. Not around when needed most
- 4. Doesn't share personal details
- 5. Chunks of time go unexplained

Check for red & yellow flags before becoming exclusive.



Christian Courting

- Being involved romantically, with intention of potentially marrying. Comes before engagement
- During this season, a man courts a woman and the relationship is exclusive.



It's All About Character

- You have character if you act same when nobody is looking.
- You are not prepared to court seriously if you are not able to love sacrificially.
- You have character when you choose to love without an immediate benefit.
- Find somebody who has integrity and sexually attracts you.

Consider Common Reasons Relationships Break-down

- Adultery/ affairs / pornography

- "The man and his wife were both naked, and they felt no shame."
 - "Naked" = transparent-open-vulnerable
 - "No shame" = fully accepting and nonjudgmental

Definition

 Expressing your gift of sexuality throughout life in a true, excellent, honest and pure way.

Sexual: involving the sexes, male and female

Integrity: wholeness, free from injury, damage or disease

True: authentic, loyal faithful

Excellent: extraordinary, remarkably good

Honest: morally good, free from deception

Pure: free from anything inferior



God Created Us to be Sexual Beings



- Solomon's Song of Songs. Let him kiss me with the kisses of his mouth-- for your love is more delightful than wine. (Song of Solomon 1:1-2)


Sexual

Survival strategy to pass on genes

Male

Inseminate as many females as possible and go with the odds of offspring survival

Female

Nurture offspring into adulthood and a good male provider/protector can help



Communication is Key!

Men spell communication S-E-X

Women spell *communication* T-A-L-K



Sex Unites

■ Do you not know that he who unites himself with a prostitute is one with her in body? For it is said, "The two will become one flesh. but he who unites himself with the Lord is one with him in spirit. (1 Corinthians 6:16)



Sex is Bonding

- Sexual activity is a bond like glue.
- Any intimate activity begins the bonding process.
- Breaking the intimacy bond is emotionally painful



Sexual Restraint builds trust

- If you control your sexual passions with me until marriage,
- Then I can trust you to be faithful during marriage.



Three Principles

- Activities that build relationship are acceptable, but activities that progress toward sexual intercourse are dangerous.
- Sexual intimacy is a train that does not move backward.
- The level of intimate contact should be equal to the level of commitment to marriage.



Resist or Flee?

Flee from sexual immorality. All other sins a man commits are outside his body, but he who sins sexually sins against his own body. (1 Corinthians 6:17)



Rebuke or Run?

Although she spoke to Joseph day after day, he refused to go to bed with her or even be with her.

One day he went into the house to attend to his duties, and none of the household servants was inside.


She caught him by his cloak and said, "Come to bed with me!" But he left his cloak in her hand and ran out of the house. (Genesis 39:10-12)

- 3. Protect the Heart






Guard the eyes

For Guys




Take captive the mind
