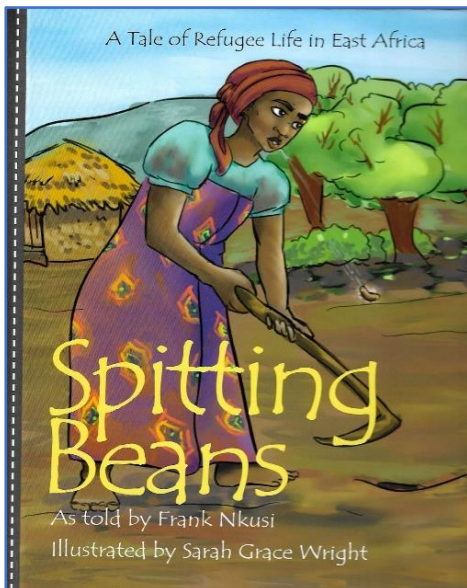
Frank is an ordained pastor, evangelist, author, teacher, and interpreter – speaking Kinyarwandan, English, French and Swahili. He is married with 4 children
